## HVAC FUNDRAISER THANK YOU

Thank you *SO MUCH* to members and friends of Carmichael Presbyterian Church who have generously donated funds to pay for the replacement of the heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) system in the Sanctuary! As of July 27, CPC has received 142 contributions totaling \$75,306. Adding in \$25,992 given in past years makes a total of \$101,298. This means that there are sufficient funds to pay for replacing the HVAC system in the Sanctuary, including any increases in contractual costs.

We are still waiting for Sacramento County to approve building permits for the HVAC project. The County previously requested that the contractor, ACCO, rework the building plans in a specific way. The reformatting was done and everything was submitted again.
