FOOD CLOSET NEEDS

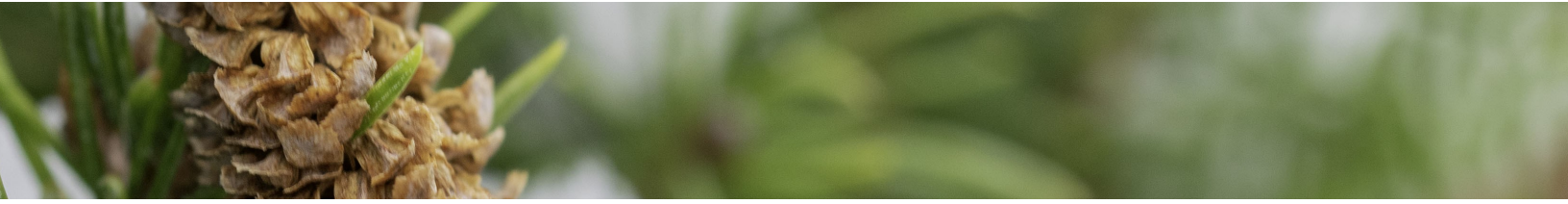
Do you have excess citrus fruits on your trees? The Food Closet would love your donation of oranges, mandarins, and grapefruit. No lemons, please.
