"The Invisible Homeless is a documentary written and directed by Nick Anderson of Bright Coast Productions and Ian Lee of Jolie Media. The film explores the Sacramento homeless crisis from the perspectives of women and children directly experiencing homelessness, as well as leaders in government, non-profits, academia, and community organizations.

Sacramento's homeless headcount has just surpassed San Francisco's numbers; the film situates itself in this present moment and looks forward to potential solutions such as affordable housing.

SCAM ALERT

Please be aware of possible scam emails—even from fellow church members and pastors. Their email accounts may have been compromised or spoofed. Most of the time the email reads:

- Do you have a free moment to get in touch with me through your email
- Can you help me with a problem by sending an email or calling me at my friend's house at this number: xxx-xxx-xxxx?
- I am traveling in a foreign country and need your help. Please reply via email as soon as you can.

It seems harmless enough, and it appears to come from an actual email address of someone you know. But scammers take over email addresses to receive responses and ask for money or gift cards. In the meantime, know that the member is unlikely the sender and JUST DELETE THE EMAIL. You may call your church friend at the phone number you know is theirs (not one in the email) to confirm it's not from them and also let them know that someone is using their email account.
