RESPONDING TO MIGRANTS IN SACRAMENTO

Less than two weeks ago 36 migrants (mostly from Venezuela and Colombia) were flown from El Paso, TX to Sacramento on private chartered flights with the promise of jobs and housing waiting for them. They were left on the doorstep of the Catholic Diocese of Sacramento, promises unfulfilled. Sacramento Area Congregations Together (SacACT) has been providing shelter, food, and clothing to these individuals as they await their political and legal stories to play out.

CPC has long been connected to SacACT, and on Monday the Mission Division approved \$1,000 to help support these needs.
