Christa is a graduate of Stanford University (BA in Classics and Economics) and Princeton Theological Seminary (M.Div. and MA in Christian Education). She will graduate this December from Columbia Theological Seminary with a D.Min. in Christian Spirituality. She also received a Diploma in the Art of Spiritual Direction from San Francisco Theological Seminary and is a certified spiritual director.

Prior to her ordination, Christa had the opportunity to serve as the assistant pastor for a year at Groomsport Presbyterian Church in Northern Ireland, and she also served as a pastoral assistant at churches in West Virginia and the Republic of Ireland. Upon ordination, Christa served for six years as the AP of The Woodlands Community Presbyterian Church in The Woodlands, TX, and she has spent the last nine years serving as an AP at First Presbyterian Church in Myrtle Beach, SC (where previous CPC pastor Carol Pagelsen held the interim for her position before her arrival and was one of her church members for seven years).

Christa has always been very active in her presbyteries and has a strong interest in serving the PCUSA at the mid-council level when God calls her to whatever comes next. Christa married Rev. Barrett Ingram in 2021, a fellow PCUSA pastor that she met in her young pastor colleague group in the greater Houston area. Barrett currently serves as the pastor of Clarkton Presbyterian Church in Clarkton, NC. In her community, Christa enjoys participating in community bands, and is entering her 9th year chairing the flute section for the North Myrtle Beach Community Concert Band. In any remaining spare time, Christa loves to explore new places locally and globally and always has her passport at the ready.
