CENTENNIAL GOODIES

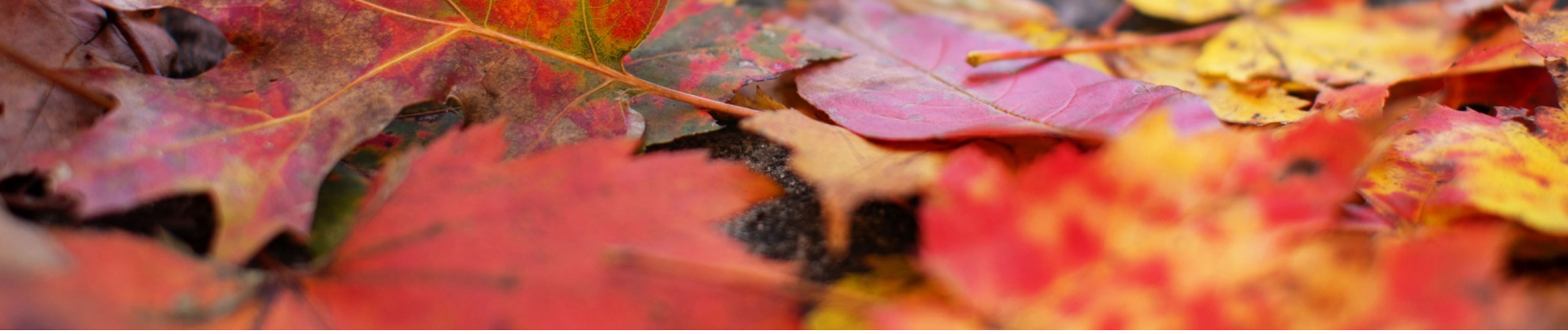
