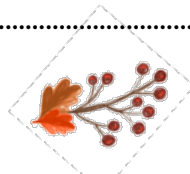

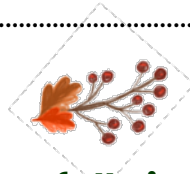

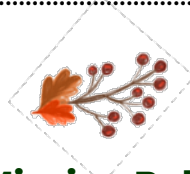

100 Years of Music



Carmichael Presbyterian Church has been praising God through music for all of its 100 years. From children singing along with a piano in the original schoolhouse during Sunday school to multiple choirs, ensembles, handbell choirs, an orchestra, musical productions, and a praise band, music is in CPC's DNA.

The groups sharing their gifts of music this afternoon are integral parts of CPC's long history of praising God and serving the community.

The **Sanctuary Choir** (also called the Chancel Choir, or simply "the choir") has provided musical leadership in worship services since the dedication of the original church building in 1927.

The **Living Water Ensemble** started as a women's ensemble in 1979 and began singing as The Living Water Ensemble in 1982. Under the direction of Trina Torgerson Spivack, the group shared beautiful harmonies with the CPC community until April 1991.

Since its humble beginnings in 1918 as a Sunday School for kids from the Carmichael area, children have joined in worship through song. Called Children's Chorus, Angelus Choir, Carol Choir, Angel Choir, and now **Waterfall Singers**, the hundreds of children who have been part of CPC's music programs have learned the joy of praising God through song.

The **Mission Bells** English handbell choir was formed in 1980. Other handbell choirs have included Chancel Ringers, B.A.C.H. Bells, and Carillon. These groups have played in churches and for other schools, organizations, and groups throughout the greater Sacramento area.

Beginning with Mark Studer and a guitar at Sunday evening worship services in 1997, the **Praise Team** now plays contemporary worship songs for nearly every Sunday service. Over the years, piano, drums, bass, more guitars, and vocalists have been added to expand the team's musical options.

CPC's first **organ** was purchased in August 1945. Since then, the Sanctuary has had several organs leading up to current organ and pipes installed in 1997.

The **Celebration Singers** began as a small vocal ensemble with director Zorana Randjelovic-Flores in 1996. Known for mostly *a cappella* music, they sang regularly in worship until 2008.
