CPC WOMEN'S RETREAT IS BACK!

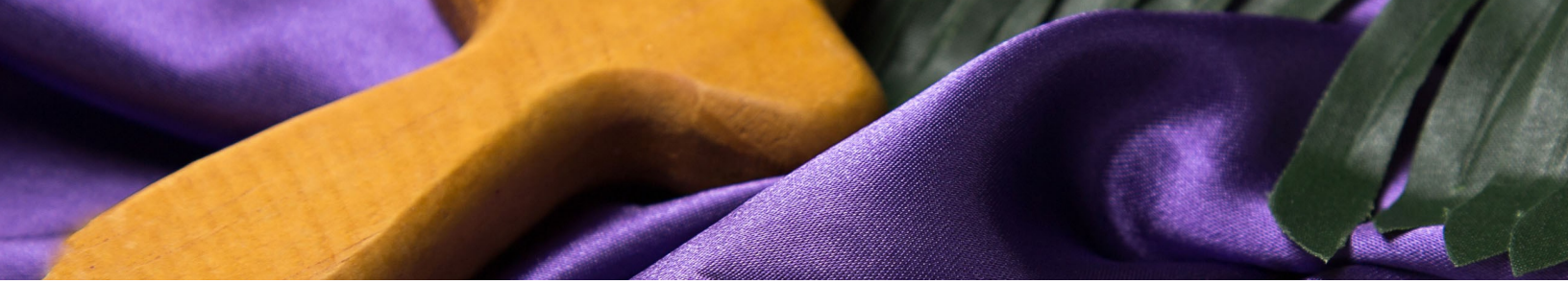
